Make a postcard journal

You will need:

Postcards, new or used

Paper / card for blank pages (you can use paper which has been printed on one side, such as old minutes), card (you can use old greetings cards or packets for this) or envelopes Hole punch

Ribbon (can be the hanging loops from garments), yarn or string Ruler or straight edge

Work surface eg a craft mat, place mat or magazines / newspapers Scoring tool, crochet hook, knitting needle or table knife

1. Punch holes in the short ends of the cards. The end you punch will be slightly hidden.

2. If you want blank pages, cut paper, card or envelopes to the size of the postcards and punch holes in them

3. Score the cards, paper, card and envelopes to make a fold at the punched end









Mark where you want the fold. Put the piece to be folded on a softer surface eg back of a placemat



Draw along the fold line with a scoring tool



Fold all of the pieces

4. Pile the postcards, card and paper in the order you want for the journal. Thread the ribbon yarn or string through the holes and tie to complete the journal
