

WREATH INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Cut a 10 circle out of corrugated card, a dinner plate should be about the right size. Using a small bowl or saucer cut a circle out of the middle. You should have a doughnut shape.
- 2. Wrap the wreath in crepe paper, a paper streamer is easy to use or paint the base. Green or brown are good colours to use.
- 3. Stick the pledge banner (on the left) on some corrugated card with PVA glue and allow to dry. When completely dry cut out the banner.
- 4. Using the template print 3 to 4 sheets of leaves using different colours of paper. Cut the leaves out. If you have a die cutting machine you could cut leaves using that. You can use the plain template and draw on the veins or use the veined template.
- 5. Cut out some plain leaves, 6 should be enough. to use to write pledges on.
- 6. Using a bone folder or pair of scissors curl the leaves to give them some dimension.
- 7. Tie a ribbon to the top of the wreath and tie a bow. You can use fabric or paper ribbon.
- 8. Glue the leaves on to the wreath, you can use hot glue or double sided pads to give some dimension. Starting at the top add leaves to each side of the bow working towards the bottom.
- 9. Add the banner across the wreath and finally add the leaf pledges.

Remember this is your wreath have fun
