Book-folded hedgehog

You will need:

book – 100 to 150 pages (100 pages for a less firm up to 200 if the paper is very thin)

double sided tape

approx 2 ft piece of ribbon

firm card approx 4in X 7in (cereal box cardboard would be fine)

button for nose

google eyes or buttons for eyes

paper / cardboard flowers, gems etc to decorate

PVA glue

glue dots (optional)

- 1. Remove the pages from the book, making sure that they are all still joined together at the spine
- 2. Put the book in front of you as shown



3. Fold the right hand corner of the first page toward the spine to make a triangle. Be careful to line up the edge of the page with the spine edge in a straight line




4. Fold the rest of the page down horizontally in half, matching the top edge of the page to the spine, Press the folds firmly.



- 5. Repeat the same process with the rest of the pages making firm folds
- 6. Put the hedgehog on the card and draw round it. Trim the card to fit the hedgehog



7. Put a piece of double sided tape about ½ way along the body and stick the ribbon to it with the middle of the ribbon roughly in the middle of the card



- 8. Stick the hedgehog to the card using PVA glue. Leave to dry thoroughly.
- 9. Tie the ribbon into a bow on top of the hedgehog
- 10. Decorate the hedgehog with eyes, nose, gems and flowers, using PVA glue or glue dots to hold them in place
