# **Little TG Ted** – by Joyce Hughes

Approx 5 inches / 13cm tall

You will only need small amounts of each colour of double-knit yarn Size 10 needles

## Make the head and body

- 1. Cast on 6 stitches in main teddy bear body colour
- 2. Knit 4 rows
- 3. Change to trouser colour
- 4. Knit 14 rows
- 5. Leaving a length of yarn to sew up Ted, cut the yarn
- 6. Knit another leg
- 7. Knit across all 12 stitches
- 8. Knit 8 rows
- 9. Change to jumper colour
- 10. Knit 14 rows
- 11. Change to main teddy bear body colour
- 12. Stocking stitch for 3 inches
- 13. Then continue to knit teddy, starting with the jumper colour, in reverse order
- 14. Stitch each the side of the head together
- 15. Stitch diagonal corners for the ears

#### Make the arms

- 1. Using the jumper colour, pick up and knit 4 stitches on one side of the neck
- Knit 8 rows
- 3. Change to main teddy bear body colour
- 4. Knit 4 rows
- 5. Cast off
- 6. Repeat for the other arm

# To finish the Ted

- 1. Stuff the head
- 2. Sew a piece of yarn with running stitches round the neck and tighten it
- 3. Sew the under-arm seams and paws
- 4. Stuff the arms
- 5. Sew the side seams and leg seams leaving an opening for stuffing.
- 6. Fill the remaining space with toy filling and close the opening.
- 7. Sew the eyes, nose and a big smile! (Please do not use beads / plastic eyes as these could come loose and be a choking hazard)

## **Optional scarf**

- 1. Cast on 50 stitches
- 2. Knit 1 row. Cast off
- 3. Sew in place
