

Two types of TIG meeting – private and public

As welcoming as your Guilds are, you might find it a bit odd if someone just wandered into your meeting one day, sat down and started to take part.

By having a private meeting, this will not happen on line. It means that your meeting will **not** appear on the website in the list of meetings and you will be sent a link to use to get into the meeting which you can then share with whoever you want to be at that meeting.

If you want to encourage other members to come to your meeting, to join an activity such as a book club, writing group, knit and natter or to listen to a speaker, then you can have a public meeting. It **will** appear in the list of meetings on the website and any members going onto that page will be able to join your meeting.

All TIG meetings are booked through Sara and when you contact her to book a meeting, she will ask you what type of meeting you want, private or public.
